Findings of Fact

THE DEPARTMENT FINDS:

- l. That the Moss American Company, Milwaukee, treats industrial wastes containing petroleum products with a gravity separator and coke filter before discharge to the Little Menomonee River.
 - 2. That said treatment facilities do not provide adequate treatment for the industrial wastes.
 - 3. That discharge of said inadequately treated wastes constitutes a source of pollution to the Little Menomonee River.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. That this Department, having reviewed the results of a public hearing of this matter, has authority under 144.025 (2) (d), <u>Wisconsin Statutes</u>, to issue a special order directing particular owners to secure such operating results toward the control of pollution of the waters of the state as the Department prescribes, within a specified time.
- 2. That the order hereinafter made for providing connection of industrial wastes, after pre-treatment, of the Moss American Company to the local sanitary system, is reasonable, proper and necessary for the protection of public rights in the Little Menomonee River.

Order

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED:

That the Moss American Company provide for the connection of their industrial wastes after pre-treatment to the local sanitary sewer system by November 1, 1970.
