Roy F. Weston, Inc. (WESTON<sub>®</sub>) has prepared this monthly progress report on behalf of the Settling Defendant for the Moss-American Superfund site, Kerr-McGee Chemical LLC (KMC). This monthly progress report has been prepared to document progress during March 1998.

## Progress During March 1998

Progress during this reporting period includes:

- On 11 March 1998, KMC/WESTON submitted the Final (100%) Groundwater Design report to U.S. EPA/WDNR.
- On 17 March 1998, KMC submitted a letter to U.S. EPA (Russ Hart) indicating that KMC generally supported the remedy changes described in the fact sheet distributed by U.S. EPA regarding the Proposed Plan.
- KMC/WESTON attended the public meeting held by U.S. EPA on 18 March 1998 regarding the Proposed Plan for the site.
- On 19 March 1998, KMC/WESTON responded to Agency comments on the General Groundwater Monitoring Program in a letter to U.S. EPA (Russ Hart).
- On 23 March 1998 through 26 March 1998, KMC/WESTON conducted the quarterly groundwater sampling in accordance with the General Groundwater Monitoring Program.
- KMC/WESTON participated with the Agencies in a conference call on 30 March 1998 to clarify certain aspects of short-term storage of excavated soils associated with implementation of the groundwater remedy.



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## Activities Anticipated During April 1998

During April, KMC/WESTON anticipate the following activities:

- KMC/WESTON will prepare to activate the free-product recovery system in early May 1998.
- KMC/WESTON await further developments and details from the land trustees regarding a possible expansion of the river remediation/restoration scope.
- KMC/WESTON await comments/approval from the Agencies on the Final (100%) Groundwater Design report.
- KMC/WESTON anticipate that additional site clearing may be accomplished in April 1998 in order to implement the revised funnel and gate layout.
- In late April, KMC/WESTON expects to receive analytical results from the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 1998 groundwater sampling. A report describing these results will then be prepared.
