Roy F. Weston, Inc. (WESTON®) has prepared this monthly progress report on behalf of the Settling Defendant for the Moss-American Superfund site, Kerr-McGee Chemical LLC (KMC). This monthly progress report has been prepared to document progress during May 2000.

Progress During May 2000

Progress during this reporting period includes:

- The QAPP amendment addressing operation and monitoring of the groundwater remedial system was submitted to the Agencies on 11 May 2000.
- The 1st quarter groundwater monitoring report is near completion and will be submitted to the Agencies shortly.
- A request for bids was sent to thirteen potential LTTD vendors on 31 May 2000. Contractor procurement therefore started 1 June 2000 (Month #1 as identified in the project schedule contained in the 100% Final Design Report for LTTD Soil Treatment dated 7 April 2000).

Activities Anticipated During June 2000

During June, KMC/WESTON anticipate the following activities:

- KMC\WESTON will attend a meeting in Milwaukee, WI on 7 June 2000 with the Agencies to discuss the status of work at the site and the river remedy.
- The remaining field work associated with installation of the groundwater remedy will begin the first week of June and should be completed by the end of June.

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- The 2nd quarter groundwater monitoring event is scheduled to occur the week of 26 June 2000.
- A mandatory pre-bid meeting for all LTTD vendors is scheduled for 13 June 2000 at the site. Bids are due from the vendors on 30 June 2000.
