Weston Solutions, Inc. (Weston®) has prepared this monthly progress report on behalf of the Settling Defendant for the Moss-American Superfund site, Kerr-McGee Chemical LLC (KMC). This monthly progress report has been prepared to document progress during May 2004.

Progress During May 2004

Progress during this reporting period includes:

 High water resulting from one of the wettest Mays on record has limited progress in new channel construction. Approximately 1150 ft of channel in Reaches 2 and 3 was excavated during the first ten days of May. Repeated rain events forced the NSE construction crew to depart from the site on 13 May. High water conditions in the Little Menomonee River made work impossible for the remainder of May.

Activities Anticipated During June 2004

During June KMC/Weston anticipate the following activities:

- Construction activities in June were also rained out for the first week of June. NSE returned to the site on 7 June to resume new channel excavation and restoration activities in the remainder of Reach 2 and Reach 3. This phase of work is now expected to be completed in by the end of June 2004.
- KMC/Weston will investigate the use of commercial amendments to optimize the handling of sediments excavated from Reach 2 and 3.
- The Q1 2004 groundwater monitoring report will be submitted.
- The Q2 2004 groundwater monitoring event will be performed during the week of 14 June.



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• KMC/Weston will submit a monitoring report for Reach 1.
