Weston Solutions, Inc. (Weston®) has prepared this monthly progress report on behalf of the Settling Defendant for the Moss-American Superfund site, Kerr-McGee Chemical LLC (KMC). This monthly progress report has been prepared to document progress during March 2005.

Progress During March 2005

Progress during this reporting period includes:

- The Q4 2004 groundwater monitoring report was submitted to the Agencies on 4 March.
- The Q1 groundwater sampling event was performed during the week of 14 March.
- KMC received a letter dated 28 March from WDNR describing its position on the approach to remediation in Reaches 4 and 5.
- On 29 March KMC received a letter from U.S. EPA dated 21 March in regards to U.S. EPA's 5-yr review of the Site. U.S. EPA requested KMC's assistance in evaluating the effectiveness of institutional controls. In order to more fully evaluate this request, KMC has asked U.S. EPA to provide a complete set of attachments to the letter, which were not included in the original transmittal.

Activities Anticipated During April 2005

During April KMC anticipate the following activities:

• On 5 April KMC met with U.S. EPA and WDNR in Milwaukee to discuss the major components and schedule for the 5-yr review of the Site.

- KMC awaits Agency comments on the recently submitted Request for Modifications to the Groundwater Monitoring Program.

- KMC will evaluate U.S. EPA's 21 March letter and attachments, and provide a response.
