Weston Solutions, Inc. (WESTON®) has prepared this monthly progress report on behalf of the Settling Defendant for the Moss-American Superfund site, Tronox LLC (Tronox), formerly Kerr-McGee Chemical LLC. This monthly progress report has been prepared to document progress during February 2006.

## Progress During February 2006

Progress during this reporting period includes:

- On 7 February Tronox provided the Agencies with an electronic submittal of the chemical data from the sediment samples collected in December 2005.
- On 15 February Tronox met with representatives of EPA and WDNR at WESTON's Vernon Hills office to discuss the results of the Reach 4 sediment sampling that was performed in December 2005. As a result of this meeting Tronox agreed to provide the Agencies with the following materials:
  - o A written report summarizing the December 2005 sampling.
  - O QAPP materials supporting forensic analyses of sediment samples to determine CPAH sources.
  - o A modified field sampling plan to address sediment sampling for the remainder of Reaches 4 and 5.



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## Activities Anticipated During March 2006

During March Tronox anticipate the following activities:

- On 2 March Tronox submitted the Q4 2005 groundwater monitoring report.
- North Star Environmental will be implementing additional erosion control measures in Reach 4a in March.
- In March Tronox will be submitting the Reach 4 Sediment Sampling report, QAPP materials, and Revised Field Sampling Plan for Reaches 4 and 5.
- Tronox is evaluating remedial options to address stagnant groundwater in the vicinity of MW-7S/MW-34S.
- Tronox will prepare a report documenting revegetation efforts in Reaches 1, 2, and 3.
- Tronox awaits Agency comments on the recently submitted Request for Modifications to the Groundwater Monitoring Program.
