Weston Solutions, Inc. (WESTON®) has prepared this monthly progress report on behalf of the Settling Defendant for the Moss-American Superfund site, Tronox LLC (Tronox), formerly Kerr-McGee Chemical LLC. This monthly progress report has been prepared to document progress during May 2006.

Progress During May 2006

Progress during this reporting period includes:

- Vandalized fences and gates were repaired during the week of 29 May. Repairs were performed at the former wood treating facility and at Calumet Road.
- On 8 May Tronox submitted a letter report to the Agencies outlining its plan to address stagnant groundwater in the vicinity of MW-7S/MW-34S.
- Weston discussed drainage issues with representatives of developers that are preparing plans for the area north of Vincent High School.
- Tronox referred Kevin Haley of Milwaukee County to Will Wawrzyn to discuss high water impacting the bike trail in Reach 3.
- In an email dated 6 June Tronox restated its desire to continue discussions regarding Reach 4/5 sediment sampling with the Agencies.
- In a letter dated 7 June Tronox proposed a soil sampling program to characterize the property at 9633 W. Brown Deer Road.

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Activities Anticipated During June 2006

During June Tronox anticipates the following activities:

- The Q2 groundwater monitoring event is scheduled for the week of 26 June.
- The Q1 groundwater monitoring report will be submitted to the Agencies in late June.
- Tronox awaits Agency concurrence on its plan to address stagnant groundwater in the vicinity of MW-7S/MW-34S.
- Tronox will prepare a report documenting revegetation efforts in Reaches 1, 2, and 3.
- Tronox awaits Agency comments on the Reach 4 Sediment Sampling Report.
- Tronox awaits Agency comments on its Request for Modifications to the Groundwater Monitoring Program.
