The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), in consultation with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR), has reviewed revisions made by Tronox, dated February 20, 2009, to the December 30, 2008 Reach 4/5 Remediation Work Plan Revision. That work plan, as revised, is hereby approved, with the modification indicated below, pursuant to Section 14(a) of the Consent Decree.
