SUBJECT: Diecast Division PCB Landfill Site Program.

Because of the restraints established by the DNR and the City of Sheboygan Falls regarding the temperatures at which the liner material could be installed, it was previously decided that unless we had the DNR and EPA landfill site permits in our hands by September 17, we could not proceed with the program this year. At the time this deadline came around, I requested Attorney Williams of Foley & Lardner to so advise the DNR of this situation. A copy of his letter to Mr. Robert Krill of the DNR is attached for your files.

The only further work we can do on the project this year is to attempt to get the DNR and the EPA required permits. Assuming these can be eventually received, the landfill program could then continue in late spring or early summer, providing we still have approval to continue.

Dear Mr. Krill:

With regard to the Consent Order involving Tecumseh Products Company ("Tecumseh"), we have been informed by Mr. David Sims of EPA Region V that EPA will likely take until the end of October to complete its technical review of Tecumseh's proposed PCB landfill in the Town of Sheboygan Falls, and, in addition, EPA may give the public time to comment on the project prior to issuing its approval. Although we have requested EPA to expedite its approval procedures so that construction can begin this fall, as indicated by the above, these efforts have not been successful.

Due to this regulatory delay, which is beyond the control of Tecumseh, it will not be possible to complete the landfill project this year. Tecumseh, though, will take all reasonable steps to complete the disposal project as soon as possible next year when the spring construction season begins.
