Spoke with RP Diana Williams (listed as Diana Stephens on BRRTS but husband died) (920) 386-4400 she said she is not aware of any contamination problem one tank was removed in 60's or 70's (tank shown on database as removed) and they have tank for waste oil burning furnace on property now. She said several years ago they did collect some soil samples and sent them in to DNR (did not indicate what these were about spill /tank removal?) but she thought they were clean samples and she never heard from the DNR. She seemed in a good mood but indicated she was having financial difficulties and would have to have PECFA eligibility to pay for any required clean-up. She gave me her email address diannawilliams21@sbcglobal.net and asked me to contact her if I find any more details (missing file) on what contamination was about. I told her I would pass her info on to DNR PM and that I would be here for another month but beyond that future contact would likely be with PM Denise Nettesheim.
