Hello Lanette.

In July of 2021 you submitted closure documentation for the Former Speedway (SuperAmerica) Station on behalf of the City of Kenosha. In August of 2020 every open site, including this site, received a letter regarding submittal of an emerging contaminant scoping statement.

The letter included the following:

Per Wis. Admin. Code § NR 716.07 and Wis. Admin. Code § NR 716.09, site investigation scoping and work plans should include an evaluation of potential PFAS compounds and other applicable emerging contaminants that were historically or are presently produced, used, handled, or stored at the site. The evaluation should include any available information on whether any products containing PFAS were used in any process services, the duration of PFAS-containing product use, the type of PFAS contained in the product, and any areas of the site where PFAS-containing products may have been used, stored, managed, or discarded. Site investigation work plans should also include a sampling and analysis strategy to be used during field investigation that considers all information in the evaluation conducted under Wis. Admin. Code § NR 716.07.

It does not appear as if an emerging contaminant scoping statement was included with the closure request. Was one submitted separately? As you should be aware, this statement is required to be submitted prior to closure consideration. Also, Table 5 on page 4 of the Form 4400-202 is incomplete. It is unclear, based on the incomplete table and the fact that the \$350.00 Database Fee for Groundwater or Monitoring Wells (Not Abandoned) was paid, what type of closure is being applied for.

Please address the above and then we can process the closure review.
