Your proposed DERF change order is approved. You may proceed with the proposed work. The DNR received the proposal titled Revised Change Order Work Plan #7, One Hour Martinizing (Dorprop LLC), prepared by Braun Intertec and submitted on your behalf on September 5, 2012.

Braun has provided sampling locations and procedures to assess deeper groundwater and subslab vapor quality at the property located at 3582 N. Oakland Avenue. The data collected will be used to determine whether and to what extent impacts from the drycleaning solvent release on 3596 N. Oakland Avenue may have migrated in groundwater and soil vapor beneath the 3582 N. Oakland Avenue property.

Cost approved for this change order is \$5,355.00 for consulting and \$1,709.00 for sub-contractors, for a total of \$7,065.00. The cost approved for this site investigation phase is \$80,139.50. The total cost approved to date for this site is \$93,063.97.

Please be aware that you are required to comply with all applicable statutes and administrative rules including the NR 700 series, Wisconsin Administrative Code, hazardous waste management and wastewater discharges.

This approval does not guarantee the reimbursement of costs under the Dry Cleaner Environmental Response Program. Final determination regarding the eligibility of costs for reimbursement will be made at the time of claim review.
