Hi Patrick,

As started earlier, the field and technical investigation for the Jill's Dry Cleaners site (FID# 268077480 BRRTS# 02-68-543070) is complete. The following documentation requirements (mostly GIS) will need to be addressed before case closure is issued:

- The Engineered Barrier map (Figure 12) will need to include both 1) the degree of soil impacts and 2) the location of the venting system. It may be best to have a separate figure to show the venting location, which would include the blower location and the vent pipe locations shown in the photos submitted.
- Hand Augers HA-6 and HA-7 should be added to the Site Layout Map (Figure 1)
- The analytical results of HA-6 & HA-7 will need to be added to the Soil Analytical Results (Table 3).
- The results of the private and municipal well samples should be included in the Groundwater Analytical Results Table (Table 1). Table 4 (spigots) will be added to the GIS packets so the spigot locations will need to be shown on the Areal Extent of Groundwater (Figure 11) and the Site Layout Map (Figure 1). The location of the municipal well sampled should also be included on at least one map.
- Due to the GW impacts off-site, the deed for the City Park will need to be provided. A Certified Survey Map (CSM) or legal description can also be submitted if a deed has not been created for the park.
- All monitoring wells should be abandoned per NR 141 and the abandonment forms submitted.
