Dear Mr. Kipp:

The State of Wisconsin divides the jurisdiction for sites contaminated by petroleum storage tank systems between the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) and the Department of Commerce (Commerce), based on statutory definitions of high, medium and low risk sites. Under this statute, oversight of sites falling under the definition of "low or medium risk" is the responsibility of Commerce rather than the WDNR.

Your site appears to fall under the definition of "low or medium risk". As such, staff at Commerce will provide further reviews of submittals and all technical assistance related to this case. Accordingly, WDNR will transfer the above referenced file to Commerce at the following address:
