Doug & Shanna:

With regard to your request for a status update on the Town & Country Laundromat site located at 7513 45th Avenue (BRRTS #02-30-543696), it was Drake's understanding that the responsible party for this site had been awaiting WDNR approval of the previously submitted scope of work & cost estimate proposals (site investigation bid) relating to this DERF-eligible site and Drake is not aware of any on-site investigation or remedial activities which have occurred since the submittal of its site investigation bid.

As you are probably aware, the responsible party had previously received an August 8, 2008 letter from the WDNR which informed the responsible party that they had received the responsible party's DERF Potential Claim Notification form and that the Dry Cleaning Fund Manager was of the belief that the RP for the site qualified as an eligible entity for purposes of the DERF program. That letter also indicated that the WDNR's project manager for the site (Shanna Laube-Anderson) would be required to "sign off on the site investigation bid before work gets started."

As discussed, Drake will attempt to contact the responsible party for this site and request that they review and complete the Form 4400-212 (which was provided by Shanna Laube-Anderson earlier this morning) so as to allow the investigation and potential cleanup of this site to continue moving forward. Thank you Shanna for forwarding that form to us so that we can attempt to get it to the responsible party.

We understand from the WDNR's letter dated January 30, 2014 that the WDNR is committed to working with dry cleaners and property owners to help determine the best way to keep the investigations and cleanups of these sites moving forward in the face of delayed reimbursements from DERF and would kindly ask that you continue to communicate with Drake any efforts made with regard to the resolution of the apparent funding problems for the DERF program.
