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Hi Alyssa,

Additional work has been completed at the above referenced site in Manitowoc. Narrative in the attached report on page 3 and 4 and Tables 2A and 2B document the details. My summary of the documentation: The other 3 SSDS systems have also been shut down at the source property former dry cleaner building and adjacent Piggly Wiggly building to determine if the systems are no longer needed, like what was previously completed with the apartment building off-site. November 2016 and January 2017 sub-slab samples from VP-1 to VP-4 have resulted in concentrations below both the small commercial and residential VRSLs. An indoor air sample was also collected in the former dry cleaner building. The indoor air sample had an exceedance of the VAL. The consultant believes this is due to three remaining drums of chemicals in the building. The plan is to properly remove the remaining drums of chemicals and resample indoor air after that has been completed to show the VAL exceedance was due to the remaining chemicals. One more sample round from VP-1 through VP-4 is also planned to be collected in May 2017. A closure resubmittal will likely be submitted soon after the next sampling round with the conclusion that the SSDS systems no longer need to be operated.
