Good morning Mark,

The results look very favorable for the soil, groundwater, and vapor sampling completed in February 2017. A few comments:

- The SSDS systems should remain off now through to the next vapor sampling round to be completed in May 2017. This will be the third and final sample round to show systems no longer need to be operated as long as the results continue to remain below VRSLs as they have so far.
- I agree with your sampling approach for the indoor air once remaining chemicals are

removed to prove that it was the source of elevated concentrations above the VAL.

- Off-site letters need to be re-issued to notify parties of closure resubmittal. If property ownership is the same, modifying the date of the letters and providing the updated figures/tables would really be the only revisions needed.
