Tauren,

I received results on Monday and prepared the attached status report. I was planning to send it out today, so your email response was very timely! (Copies will go in today's mail).

May sub-floor probe and indoor air sample results are favorable.

The only reason I would like to abandon the wells prior to submitting the off-site letters is let the property owner know that the well on their property have been abandoned (there are wells on 3 of the 5 off-site properties).

We will wait until after case closure is approved before abandoning the wells.

After you get a chance to review, please let me know if I should go ahead and re-send the off-site letters (with updated tables and figures).

Also, I would like to send a draft long-term maintenance plan for review (while within the 30-day waiting period for off-site letters). That would make the case closure documents easier to review and approve.

Hi Mark,

Have you gotten the sub-slab vapor and indoor air results back yet and were they below vapor risk screening levels (VRSLs) and vapor action levels (VALs) as we expected? I have reviewed the MW-10 results, which continue to be below the ES, so that is good for the closure. I am very confident this case will close since you have done a great job addressing all the items that were outlined in the denial letter; I still don't normally like to recommend monitoring well abandonment prior to getting closure approval from the closure committee though. Is there a reason why you want to abandon the wells prior to the closure re-review?

If the vapor results are good and you are ready to resubmit the closure, then you can resend the off-site letters with the updated figures/tables so we can get the 30 day notification period taken care of.

Please submit the sub-slab vapor and indoor air results when you have received them. If you have any questions, please let me know.
