Your proposed Remedial Action Change Order #8 is approved. You may proceed with the proposed work. The DNR received the proposed remedial action change order #8 prepared by MSA and submitted on your behalf on February 26, 2018.

The work proposed includes installing a monitoring well nest, groundwater sampling, surveying, updating tables and figures, assess vapor intrusion, and report preparation. In addition to the work detailed in the Change Order, please provide isoconcentration figures for TCE and PCE for the final sampling event, and provide a pumping activity summary for the two municipal wells the days the water levels are collected.


Costs approved for this change order are \$17,780.00 for consulting and \$14,040.00 for sub-contractor, for a total of \$31,820.00. The original cost approved for remedial action was \$96,300.00. The total cost approved for remedial action is \$221,107.00. The total cost approved to date for this site is \$270,382.00.

Please be aware that you are required to comply with all applicable statutes and administrative rules including the NR 700 series, Wisconsin Administrative Code, hazardous waste management and wastewater discharges.

This approval does not guarantee the reimbursement of costs under the Dry Cleaner Environmental Response Program. Final determination regarding the eligibility of costs for reimbursement will be made at the time of claim review.
