Attached is a figure with our proposed sampling locations to define the plume for the Laundry Basket site in Luck, WI. We propose that instead of installing monitoring wells we use a geoprobe to take discrete water samples at 10 feet, 30 feet and/or 50 feet (depending on the location) in order to provide horizontal and vertical definition to the plume. We would also conduct a full round of groundwater sampling simultaneously to further define the existing conditions on the site. Let me know what you think or if you have any questions.
