Dear Mr. Richard:

Based on the results included in the MSA <u>Status Report – Monitoring Well Sampling and Direct Push Groundwater Sampling</u> report submitted to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) on March 10, 2020 and consultation with the WDNR project manager, it appears that additional monitoring well sampling is necessary to monitor the increasing contaminant trends in monitoring wells MW-13D and MW-15D and to provide additional data to determine if the contaminant plume is a threat to the Village of Luck Municipal Well #2. To collect the additional data, MSA is proposing a year of limited groundwater sampling events to collect additional data that will be used to determine if there is sufficient evidence for site closure or if additional groundwater monitoring is needed.

MSA proposes that groundwater samples be collected from the following monitoring wells in four (4) quarterly sampling events:

- Monitoring wells MW-13D, MW-15D, MW-17, MW-17-40 and MW-17-70 located on the St. Croix Hardwoods property;
- Luck Telephone wells MW-6-30, MW-6-50, MW-10-30 and MW-10-50; and
- The Village of Luck Municipal Well #2.

All ten (10) wells will be sampled for VOCs using EPA Method 8260 and one (1) duplicate and a trip blank will also be collected during each sampling event for a total of forty-eight (48) samples. The results from this sampling will be added to the site groundwater sampling result tables and will be summarized in a letter report after the fourth sampling event.

#### Cost Estimate for Change Order #12

The attached DERF Site Investigation Bid Sheets include the costs to complete the above described activities and totals \$6,760.00 consultant, \$3,360.00 contractor costs (laboratory), and \$790.00 miscellaneous costs, which totals \$10,910.00.
