On behalf of the City of Manitowoc, Stantec Consulting Services (Stantec) has prepared this addendum letter to the Stantec (2016) Pre-Demolition Inspection for Asbestos and Lead Paint report dated September 21, 2016 for the property located at 1512 Washington Street in the City of Manitowoc, Wisconsin (herein referred to as the Site).

The Stantec (2016) report included an estimate calculated by NorthStar Environmental Testing (NorthStar; Mosinee, WI) of the area of the grey friable asbestos coating on the exterior of the northwest building at the Site. Upon further review of the building by Holian Asbestos Removal & Encapsulation Corp (Spring Grove, IL) and NorthStar, the area of the grey friable asbestos coating estimated by NorthStar and included in Stantec (2016) should be increased by 13,498 square feet for a total estimate of 25,728 square feet.
