Good afternoon Tauren,

Thanks for reaching out concerning the status of the former Mirro Plant No. 9 property located in Manitowoc. This e-mail provides a response and status update to the items addressed in your e-mail.

The ongoing site investigation activities as presented in the Site Investigation Work Plan are mostly complete with the exception of the off-site soil borings and monitoring well installations. As you are aware, we have reached out to four property owners; however, to date only one property owner (1501 Marshall Street) has provided a signed access agreement. We have attempted to contact the three remaining property owners through telephone, e-mail, and/or physical mail/courier over the previous 3 months and have not been able to obtain a signed agreement. Ramboll, with the assistance of Newell's legal counsel, Schiff Hardin, will attempt to contact the remaining three property owners again over the next couple of weeks; however, we will be scheduling the off-site soil boring/monitoring well installation at 1501 Marshall Street during the fourth quarter of 2021.

Ramboll is also working on the Site Investigation Report documenting activities completed from December 2020 to present with the intent of including the results from any of the off-site monitoring wells installed during the remainder of 2021. Ramboll anticipates submitting the Site Investigation Report to the WDNR during the first quarter of 2022.

Ramboll will keep WDNR and the City of Manitowoc informed on our proposed activities.
