After careful review of the submitted proposals and the DERF Site Investigation Bid Summary Consultant Selection Cover Sheet, the Department is approving your request to hire Sigma for the site investigation activities at the Master Drycleaning site.

The Department currently has no changes to the scope of work presented in Sigma's proposal. Once the Department receives the workplan for the site investigation, the Department will review and issue an approval of the scope of work and associated cost. Please note that the workplan must include a site map with source areas identified and proposed sample point locations.

Please be aware that you are required to comply with <u>all</u> applicable statutes and administrative rules including the NR 700 series, Wisconsin Administrative Code, hazardous waste management and wastewater discharges. In addition, please be aware that this letter does not represent Department "certification" that any response actions taken at your property, such as site investigation, remedial action or case closure under the ch. NR 700 series, are "approved by the Department," as those terms are used in the "remediated property; purchaser liability" section of the hazardous substance discharge law, s. 292.11, Stats. This approval does not guarantee the reimbursement of costs under the Dry Cleaner Environmental Response Program. Final determination regarding the eligibility of costs for reimbursement will be made at the time of claim review.
