After review, the additional and historic data do not constitute stable or decreasing trends in groundwater. MW-10 continues to have an increasing trend for benzene and the furthest downgradient well (MW-20) has an enforcement standard for benzene once again. As a result, at this time, the monitoring wells should not be abandoned at this site. Please contact me if you would like to discuss this further.
