You don't need to retract the application – we can process them. I wouldn't be conducting any VPLE reviews until you pay a deposit, and then, I would start by reviewing the Phase I reports. Anything review related to the Dry cleaner release I would not be billing to VPLE. Since I have not reviewed the Phase I, I cannot say that we would not be requiring any other investigation related to other historic use of the property (although I suspect not). Review of the Phase I and Phase II is a requirement of the VPLE process to ensure that all potential contaminant sources have been investigated. I'm not sure what you mean by the last sentence. To be eligible for VPLE, there must be a discharge (release) originating on the property. Call if you have additional questions and/or let me know about the applications. Thanks.
