Dear Mr. Schoeman:

The Wisconsin Department of Commerce (Commerce) is again requesting information regarding activities associated with petroleum contamination at the sites referenced above. I had contacted the City of Princeton in September 2008 and March 2009 and was promised an update. I have received nothing to date.

The City of Princeton needs to provide a plan to fulfill their responsibility to address the petroleum contamination at the above referenced sites. <u>Under current regulations, many sites require little or no cleanup actions after adequate characterization and risk assessment are performed</u>. I will work with you or your consultant to move this site to closure in a cost effective manner.

Within 15 days, please inform Commerce of your intentions to bring this case to closure. If there is no movement from the City of Princeton, Commerce will be forced to pursue enforcement action.
