
**AFFIDAVIT OF STEPHANIE JUDGE

Stephanie Judge, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am the daughter of Thomas J. Judge and Marsha Judge.
2. Thomas J. Judge is deceased, having passed away on February 7, 2009.
3. I am the personal representative of the estate of Thomas J. Judge.
4. Prior to his death, Thomas J. Judge had applied and been accepted as an eligible applicant with the Dry Cleaner Environmental Response Program (DERF), currently administered by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) under ch. NR 169, Wis. Admin. Code.
5. On September 30, 2019, the estate of Thomas J. Judge caused to be created the Thomas J. Judge Remediation Trust (Trust), a copy of which has been provided to the DNR.
6. The purpose of the Trust is to ensure the continuation of site investigation, interim and remedial response actions, and the recovery of any eligible costs under DERF, at DERF eligible sites formerly owned or operated by Thomas J. Judge, whether the sites were owned directly or through a corporation, and whether the sites were owned individually or as marital property.
7. I am the Trustee of the Trust.
8. The purpose of this affidavit is to enable the DNR to transfer the named DERF eligibility from Thomas J. Judge to the Thomas J. Judge Remediation Trust.
9. As Trustee, I will act in good faith to utilize reimbursement funds received from the DERF program and from the Escrow Account to take eligible site investigation, interim, and remedial response actions, and to pay any other costs

necessary to achieve regulatory final closure, until such funds have been used in full, including any available reimbursement funds from DERF, or until all eligible sites have been remediated to the extent required by law.
