The latest information I have received from the Department of Revenue (DOR), states that all dry cleaning license fees are paid up to date at this site. As required by State Statute 292.65(4)(d), I am advising you that, based on the preliminary information you provided on the notification form, I estimate that you are eligible to apply to the program for reimbursement of your cleanup costs. License fees will need to continue to remain up to date in order for you to receive reimbursements. The Department of Revenue will provide me the status on license fees due when I receive your payment reimbursement request.

Please also be aware that, due to increasing demand on the DERF for reimbursements, there is a possibility that reimbursements will be delayed. At this time, we are unable to predict the length of this delay in reimbursement, but audited claims will be reimbursed on a first-come, first-serve basis as funds become available.
