Kristin,

Several things:

1. Were the revised documents I sent you on 11/14 sufficient?
2. Can the vapor point abandonment documentation be a separate submittal (like well abandonment forms typically done after closure) or does it need to be included as part of this final revised closure package.
3. Also, I think we may have talked about this, but it is not clear in my mind now; regarding changes to Attachment G...Does a whole new notification need to be prepared and submitted to Phil Lee or just make only appropriate changes to include in Attachment G such as some language in the letter to combine 716 with the source property and removing VMS language and continuing obligations (may require RP to sign again?), eliminating the separate 716 Danz letter etc?
4. I should be able to get you the revised closure the week of 11/27, with answers to these questions.

Scott – Thanks for talking with me today regarding the SSDS, abandonment of the vapor monitoring points, the revised maintenance plan and figures associated with the Royal Cleaners site. Per our discussion, it is acceptable to incorporate the sealed sump requirement into the cap maintenance plan. Please add the applicable sealed sump language from the vapor maintenance plan into the cap maintenance plan. A separate vapor maintenance plan will not be required. The sealed sump inspections can be incorporated under “other” on the Continuing Obligations Inspection Log, Form 4400-305.
