RE: Clarification of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Decision
Regarding Point of Entry Water Treatment Device to be Installed at 1752
Manchester Drive, Grafton, Wisconsin

Dear Madam and Sirs:

Thank you for the opportunity to speak with all of you on April 3, 1997 regarding the point of entry water treatment device to be installed at the Hospel residence in Grafton, Wisconsin. As you are well aware, the Department has recently issued a decision approving the installation of a point of entry water treatment device, provided that certain terms and conditions regarding the installation, operation and maintenance of this system are met. These conditions are set forth in a letter dated March 21, 1997 addressed to Mr. and Mrs. Aloys Hospel. With respect to the items set forth in the "Conclusions and Recommendations" section of the decision, it is my understanding that the Department will purchase and install the system, and will be responsible for ensuring compliance with the matters set forth in paragraphs 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10 and 11 and the cost associated therewith. It is my further understanding that the Department would like Mr. Hospel's assistance with recording the total flow through the system on a weekly basis as specified in paragraph 3.

With regard to paragraph 8, which specifies that the residence should connect to a public water supply system within 30 days after such a system becomes available, it is my understanding that the Department does not intend, by the use of this language, to require the Hospels to connect to a public system if such a system is only "available" as a condition of annexation into the Village of Grafton, assessments for improvements levied against the property, etc. It is my understanding that the Department is only interested in ensuring that the

residence connect to a public water supply system if such a system is available upon reasonable terms and conditions.

Finally, as you know, Mr. Hospel has consented to a temporary delay in the installation of this system. As such, I would anticipate that you will be in contact with the Hospels as this process proceeds. I also anticipate and request that you contact me immediately if I have mischaracterized any of the circumstances surrounding this matter. Thank you for your time and attention.
