Dear Chad:

On behalf of the Village of Grafton, Rust Environment & Infrastructure (Rust) would like to request that the following private wells remain accessible and not be abandoned during the extension of Village water to homes in the Manchester subdivision and along Green Bay Road. These wells will be disconnected from each homes' distribution system so that they are not available for use. We are making this request so as to be able to use these wells to collect geologic and water quality information during the Lime Kiln Landfill site investigation. It would be much more cost-effective to use some of these existing wells because of the high cost of drilling through the bedrock.

Data that we are anticipating to collect from select wells include borehole geophysical logging information, hydraulic information from the open borehole part of the well, and additional water quality information. We have chosen these wells based on 1) the distribution of wells, 2) the distribution of contaminant concentrations, and 3) the length of the open rock borehole of the wells.

The wells we would like to keep are as follows:


1. McCormack, 1711 Manchester Drive (old and new wells if both available)

7. Rusch/Kersten, 812 Green Bay Road
8. Either Traband, Altenbach, or Gandt, 696, 688, or 678 Green Bay Road
9. Johnson, 1749 Manchester Drive
10. Carnell, 1788 Manchester Drive
11. Grafton Dells, 622 Green Bay Road
