On behalf of the Village of Grafton, I am writing in response to our telephone conversation on December 23, 1997, concerning your Plan Approval letter dated December 3, 1997, and our response letter dated December 10, 1997, for the Lime Kiln Landfill site in Grafton, Wisconsin.

You indicated that the Department still thought that the additional borings and wells requested in your December 3, 1997 letter were necessary for the Lime Kiln Landfill investigation and inquired about the actions the Village would be taking concerning moving forward with the investigation based on this response. The Village plans to move forward with the investigation as proposed in the Work Plan. Therefore, preparation of subcontractor specifications and agreements will be prepared over the next few weeks.

The Village will not install the additional borings and wells at this time as stated in the December 10, 1997, letter. Please provide any information available concerning sites where contamination was not found at the source but was discovered at high concentrations below the source. This information is necessary in order to evaluate any future need for additional borings/wells.
