Dear Ms. Underwood:

This is to request a projected schedule for when your firm, acting for the Town of Grafton, will sample four private wells designated as potentially at risk should the contamination plume spread beyond the established Village Water Service Area.

This was discussed publicly as a prudent and responsible measure to assure protection of remaining private wells in the Township, and should be part of the Village's long term plan for investigation and remediation of the site.

I'm enclosing my letter of October 28, 1997 which lists four wells (and three alternates). Two of these residents (Stockwell and Watts) recently contacted me inquiring about this matter. I would appreciate your reply. I can be reached at (414)263-8628 in Milwaukee.
