Please find attached the initial proposal for additional work to be completed at the Village of Grafton - West Plume site area. The letter includes what was agreed upon at our May 23rd meeting and the follow-up correspondence, that is attached.

One item listed in the May 29 agreement summary is information regarding interviews and research that Winder Hess performed as a private investigator during the original Lime Kiln investigation. If that information is required by the WDNR, it will have to come from Buck Sweeney. Buck mentioned to me that the information is under attorney-client privilege. We do not and never did have that information at Earth Tech.

The letter is time sensitive - the Village Board meeting for September has a deadline of August 26 for agenda items. If you wish this proposal to start in motion in a timely manner, it should be approved by then.

Even if approved by September, it will be at least 30 days after the September board meeting to complete and approve a contract, at which time we could begin the work plan. If approved by August 26, we could potentially be in the field in late October. It would be good to do the field work before the snow flies. That timing also allows us to fit into the Lime Kiln monitoring schedule without any delays.
