Greetings Mr. Thompson,

The purpose of this email is to respond to your letter of November 20, 2023 stating that closure was not recommended for the Newman Appraisal Service site in Amherst. The letter specified additional requirements needed for case closure and included:

- An additional round of sub-slab and indoor air sampling
- Additional soil sampling near MW-2.

We intend to collect two sub-slab vapor samples and one indoor air sample from the former Newman Appraisal building during the last week of February. Samples will be collected in Suma canisters with 200 ml/min flow controllers for the sub-slab samples and 8-hour flow controller for the indoor air sample.

An additional soil sample may be collected from near the location of former MW-2 at depths of greater than 3 feet.

Your letter requested a response within 60 days, and we are past that timeline. We apologize for the delay, and trust that the scope of work described above sufficiently addresses the request for additional actions.
