Your proposed change order for the above-referenced site is approved. You may proceed with the proposed work. The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) received the Change Order 7, entitled *Interim Environmental Remedial Action Planning*, prepared by Sand County Environmental on March 17, 2022.

Sand County has proposed the following work:

- Project management;
- Groundwater monitoring and field conditions assessment;
- Data evaluation and interim remedial action assessment;
- Interim remedial action plan report;

Costs approved for this change order are \$8,350 for consulting and \$870 for subcontractors, for a total of \$9,220. The cumulative site investigation costs approved for this site are \$41,607 for consulting and \$28,078 for subcontractors. Interim action costs approved for this change order are \$4,640. The total cost approved to date for this site, including site investigation and interim actions, is \$90,881.
