As we discussed on the phone there are a few changes we need made to the submitted maps, tables and figures:

B.2.a. soil contamination line; move the northern line to land between B-7(2020) and B-3/B-8.
 *relabel nomenclature for borings conducted in 2020. Using B-1 through B-9 when already assigned to historic data points is very confusing. This relabeling should follow through in maps, tables and notes in the tables.

• A.2. Soil Analytical Results Table

- 1.) missing units
- 2.) bold, italicize, underline.... any exceedances including groundwater pathway RCLs

 **please note that while this isn't a concern for this site I wanted to point out that the PERC
- detection results are higher than the groundwater pathway RCLs. It's advisable to understand and double check with the lab that they are able to meet low enough detection levels so that standards can be evaluated. Again, this is not an issue for this site but thought it was worth pointing out.
- 3.) As stated in B.2.a change the nomenclature for the 2020 sampling so it is not conflicting with historic data.
 - A.3 missing units
 - VAPOR; I confirmed with the closure committee that the sample that was collected from SVE V-6 does not properly address sub-slab vapors but rather confirms the SVE works appropriately.
 The request for a sub slab vapor sample is to evaluate the conditions below the building without the SVE system running. Please collect a sub-slab vapor sample compliant to RR-800.
 - Fees; No groundwater database fee is needed as it was already submitted
