Dear Ms. Betzold:

On behalf of Shorewood Queensway Cleaners, this letter constitutes a request to allow Environmental Forensic Investigations, Inc. (EnviroForensics) access to install one (1) soil boring, and collect groundwater and soil samples from this boring, on your property located adjacent and directly east of Shorewood Queensway Cleaners (4300 N Oakland Ave) in the Village of Shorewood, Wisconsin. The soil boring is part of an environmental investigation and remediation being performed at the direction of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) pursuant to the authority granted to it under state and Federal law. Under its legal authority, the WDNR is requiring the Shorewood Queensway Cleaners (BRRTS 02-41-552089) to investigate and remediate soil and groundwater contamination initially identified at their facility. EnviroForensics is the environmental consultant for Shorewood Queensway Cleaners.

One (1) boring will be installed on your property as depicted in Figure 1, attached. The soil boring will be advanced down to groundwater using a direct-push drill rig to a depth of approximately 25-30 feet below ground surface (bgs). The boring will be approximately 3 inches in diameter. Soil and/or groundwater samples will be collected from the boring. After the soil and groundwater samples have been collected, the boring will be filled-in to the ground surface elevation with a mixture of bentonite and water, and topped-off with soil/grass, asphalt, or concrete (as appropriate) to its original condition. It will take approximately 2 hours to install the boring.

EnviroForensics does not anticipate there will be any damage to your property from the soil boring activities. Nonetheless, EnviroForensics agrees to promptly repair any damages to your property caused by our field activities.

We anticipate being on-site during the week of November 9-13. You will be notified at least three days in planned advance of the start of activities. If you agree to site access, please sign this "Access Agreement" form and return a copy to our office.


