Thank you for talking with me today about the potential environmental condition at your clients property identified above. Please have your client contact me at 262-884-2344 so that I can update them on this situation and our access needs and answer any questions they may have. Please let me know when you conveyed this message to your client.

The Martino property is known to have had a release of dry cleaning chemicals in the environment. These compounds are known to migrate in soil gas and shallow groundwater and could impact indoor air quality in dwellings where they may represent an acute risk to fetal development in pregnant women and represent chronic risk to all others. Care should be taken to assess and, if necessary, mitigate this potential exposure in any existing or future dwellings. Access to your property is necessary for us to continue this important assessment work.

Sites where discharges to the environment have been reported are entered into the Bureau for Remediation and Redevelopment Tracking System ("BRRTS"), a version of which appears on the DNR's internet site. You may view the information related to this site at any time (<http://dnr.wi.gov/botw/SetUpBasicSearchForm.do>) and use the feedback system to alert us to any errors in the data.
