Dear Mr. and Mrs. Gulick:

The purpose of this letter is to confirm our August 13, 2015 telephone conversation regarding our offer to install a vapor intrusion mitigation system in your home. As we discussed, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) recently adopted higher screening levels for chemicals detected in sub-slab vapor. Applying this change to the results of previous sampling, your home no longer exceeds the screening levels.

We contacted you by telephone on August 13, 2015 to discuss our prior offer to install a vapor mitigation system in your home in light of the WDNR screening level changes. During our conversation, you stated that you preferred not to have a vapor mitigation system installed.

While we will no longer request access to your home for vapor intrusion sampling or mitigation, we will likely request access to your property periodically to collect groundwater samples from the previously installed sampling points. We will contact you to schedule these groundwater sampling events.
