## John:

We did not highlight this in our consultant justification letter, but Terracon's proposal is a phased approach, written such that the number of laboratory samples collected and number and location of groundwater monitoring wells are based on field screening and actual laboratory results. Therefore, the scope of work and associated costs are projected, but may not be necessary depending on the results. It is our experience that Site Investigation proposals written to meet the minimum requirements invariably require change orders. This can add a minimum of six months to a project (to write the change order and have DNR approval). We believe that this site will benefit from the phased investigation approach.

Based on this, can you reconsider our consultant selection of Terracon?
