Jane,

I had reached out to Midwest Environmental Consulting for an update on the dewatering project near the Martino's site. This was his response:

- I spoke with Brad Hucke, the Project Manager for Globe Contractors this morning. He told me that they've working in the area near Martinos and groundwater has been below their working grade. So they don't think they're going to need to run the dewatering system at all. I'll let you know if that changes.

If they don't have to pump water that would probably be for the best. We sampled a few wells for PFAS recently and while there were some hits of PFOS barely above the PAL levels there was nothing close to the ES. I don't think PFAS will be an impediment to site closure.
