Kathy,

I left you a voice mail yesterday, but thought I would email as well. Thought we may have discussed vapor mitigation systems last June, but didn't find notes to that affect. Just wondering what the current thought is within WDNR regarding a VMS within an active dry cleaner. I'm thinking it isn't applicable and should not be installed because there is no way to distinguish between contributions to indoor air quality from the subsurface versus contributions from the operations and as such the indoor air quality is subject solely to OSHA regs. Thought on this subject has certainly evolved over the last 6 years, but current thought is pertinent to Dry Cleaners Etc. Also, I know we discussed doing sub-slab sampling of nearby structures including the public library to the north, but don't recall a decision on any continued monitoring of the sub-slab point within the dry cleaners. Initially we had 9,270 ug/m3 PCE and 740 ug/m3 TCE in the drycleaner sub-slab point. Any general thoughts on these subjects as it would apply to Cry Cleaners Etc and moving forward?
