Rob,

I have reviewed the April 27, 2022 Site Investigation Work Plan and have the following comments:

- The wells selected for PFAS sampling is in line with the DNR's request and this email constitutes your notice to proceed.
- Regarding PCE, concentrations in MW-3 show an increasing trend and MW-4 shows no strong trend. If you are looking at closing the site with natural attenuation for the groundwater remedy, additional monitoring may be needed to determine conditions for degradation are present and that it is occurring. Do you also plan to continue sample for chlorinated VOCs during this sampling event?

For reference, additional guidance on CVOCs and natural attenuation are provided in RR-699.
