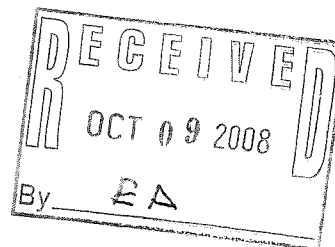

Dear Mr. Amadi:

Wabash Alloys LLC (“Wabash”) has received your letter of April 7, 2008 regarding possible contamination at the facility located at 9100 South 5th Avenue, Oak Creek, Wisconsin. In addition, I participated in a meeting with you and Ms. Darsi Foss on July 17, 2008 along with other potentially responsible parties.

Subsequent to that meeting, the activities conducted by Wabash at the Oak Creek facility were reviewed in depth. As a result of that review and taking into consideration the type of contamination alleged to be present on this site, Wabash has determined that it was not responsible for the contamination at this site.

I further understand that it is the policy of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to seek remediation of contamination from the parties who actually caused the contamination whenever feasible. Accordingly, Wabash respectfully requests that the Department pursue the party responsible for this contamination.
