The Department of Natural Resources (Department) has reviewed the submittal, *Phase II ESA, VPLE Work Plan - PCBs and Metals, Wabash Alloys, Oak Creek, WI*, dated February 4, 2013, prepared by Natural Resource Technology (NRT). The submittal proposes sampling locations to be implemented during the Phase II Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) of the subject Property. The objective of the work plan is to complete a Phase II ESA to obtain a partial Certificate of Completion (CoC) for compounds related to aluminum smelting operation namely polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) and metals. Site investigation and remedial action of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and semi-volatile organic compounds (SVOCs) including polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs), related to the former coal tar distillation plant operation are being addressed by Beazer East and not included in the referenced work plan.

The Department would like to let you know that a full Phase II ESA and site investigation for all compounds of concern (VOCs, SVOCs, PCBs and metals) on the entire Property, is required prior to issuing the requested partial CoC (per s. 292.25(2)(am), Wis. Stats.). At this time, the site investigation of all VOCs, SVOCs including PAHs, has not been completed.

The Department will also contact NRT regarding the specifics of the work plan requirements (sampling rationale, maps, data presentation, etc.), to be provided in order to meet the VPLE program criteria.
