
On July 26, 2017 the Department of Natural Resources met with representatives from Beazer East, Inc. (Beazer) during an Enforcement Conference to discuss the violation alleged in the July 14, 2017 Notice of Violation (NOV). During the Enforcement Conference, it was agreed that the department and Beazer would have a subsequent meeting to discuss the technical details regarding the site investigation and proposed remedial actions. The meeting was held on August 17, 2017.

The department would like to thank the representatives of Beazer for meeting with the department. It was a great opportunity to address Beazer's concerns, further understand Beazer's position, and discuss the technical aspects. The meeting concluded with Beazer's commitment to submit a letter to the department by September 1, 2017 indicating the steps Beazer is willing to take to address the violations alleged in the NOV. As requested during the meeting, please ensure at least the following items are included in the letter:

1. Commitment to conduct additional soil borings, install additional groundwater monitoring wells, and conduct additional waste characterization.
2. An estimated timeline to return to compliance. This timeline should include when Beazer plans to submit an amendment to the site investigation report responsive to number 1 and an estimated date a revised Remedial Action Options Report will be submitted.
