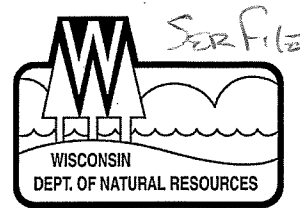

Dear Mr. & Mrs. Fox:

On 12/04/09, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) sent a Responsible Party letter notifying you of contamination at the Subject site. The intent of this letter is to remind you of your responsibility to investigate and, as needed, clean up this contamination. The petroleum contamination apparently resulted from site operations. Therefore, soil and groundwater delineation and groundwater monitoring are required. As the responsible party of this property you have certain legal responsibilities which are outlined in Section 292.11(3), Wisconsin Stats., also known as the hazardous substances spills law. Section 292.11(3) states:

- **RESPONSIBILITY.** A person who possesses or controls a hazardous substance which is discharged or who causes the discharge of a hazardous substance shall take the actions necessary to restore the environment to the extent practicable and minimize the harmful effects from the discharge to the air, lands or waters of the State.

Our files indicate that we have not received any written correspondence or reporting for the case since the *RP* letter was sent on 12/04/09. In order to get this case back on track toward investigation and/or remediation, and ultimately to WDNR case closure, please submit a status report summarizing this case. The document should include soil and groundwater investigation updates and appropriate recommendations. Please have your consultant notify the department in writing within the next thirty days to state your intentions or to submit the requested documentation. If you do not have a consultant, please contact the WDNR for further assistance. A lack of response to this letter may result in initiating formal enforcement actions.
