Good Afternoon,

On May 5, 2017, AECOM, on behalf of the city of Kenosha, requested approval of the proposed disposal location for solid waste generated at the Mankowski Property (BRRTS# 02-30-554934) in general conformance with the requirements of the Ready for Reuse Grant Agreement RRG-046 Section V Special Conditions, paragraph 9.

AECOM has demonstrated that some soils at the Mankowski site that are contaminated with TCE are not characteristically hazardous waste. This soil can be taken to a Subtitle D landfill.

Other soils at the Mankowski site have to be treated in situ because they failed the TCLP test for TCE. AECOM will take confirmatory soil samples following in situ treatment and analyze them for TCLP. As long as the soil that has been treated passes the TCLP test for TCE, then this treated soil can be taken to a Subtitle D landfill.

AECOM and the city have selected Kestrel Hawk, a Subtitle D landfill located in Racine, for disposal of excavated contaminated soil. I have been contacted by Christine Haag, DNR's Brownfields and Outreach Section Chief, who stated that she agrees that Kestrel Hawk is an acceptable disposal location, therefore, DNR approves of Kestrel Hawk as the disposal location.
